- c. Itinerary In addition to the zoo tour, students will participate in a program that directly and effectively supports the content we teach in accordance with the Science Massachusetts Curriculum Frameworks.
- d. Summary of trip purpose/educational alignment The fifth grade will be participating in the "Web of Life" program which directly relates to the Life Science Standard; Ecosystems: Interactions, Energy, and Dynamics. This is the description from the zoo website Web of Life A healthy ecosystem is one in which multiple species of different types are each able to meet their needs in a relatively stable web of life. Students will examine how organisms in a local ecosystem are interrelated.
