- a. Destination- Rock Spot (Lincoln, RI)
- b. Departure/expected return dates- (2pm 12/13 return 5pm 12/13)
- c. Itinerary- 2 hours of supervised climbing and games. Rock spots staff will belay (hold the ropes), offer encouragement, and lead participants through climbing and team-building games.
- d. Summary of trip purpose/educational alignment- *The purpose is to build student self-confidence and develop "team-building" ethics.*
- e. Trip expense, inclusive of all costs- \$35 (Includes instruction time, rock climbing shoes, gym time, and bus cost)
