# Franklin Boys Basketball

Dear Members of the School Committee, Dr. Ahern, and Principal Hanna:

In 2012, when I was serving as the Boys Varsity Basketball Coach at Foxboro High School, I had the opportunity to take a special group of players on a field trip of a lifetime. Despite this trip being nearly a decade ago, the memories we made have remained with myself and my players to this very day.

Franklin Basketball is about three things: positive relationships, always acting how you want to be remembered, and being a part of something bigger than yourself. We believe that this trip to Orlando embodies everything that the Franklin High School Boys Basketball Program, and the Franklin High School Community strive for.

This trip would provide our student-athletes with a unique experience to grow and challenge themselves in the adolescent stage of their lives. - B. How can we afford the trip:
  - 1. Our booster organization and players held a very successful golf tournament last year and we anticipate another successful event in 2022. With profits from these events, it is our goal to fully fund the trip.
  - 2. The remaining balance will be paid for through other fundraising initiatives over the course of the next 5 months, donations, grants, and possible reasonable contributions from each family. If any family is unable to contribute financially, the Franklin Basketball Boosters will provide financial assistance as needed.
  - 3. No money will be needed from the town, school, or athletic department to fund the trip.
  - 4. Trip insurance will be purchased to protect our families.



Step 4: Choose a Billing Option. Do you want to do one group bill for your team, or do you want each athlete to register individually?

Step 5: Submit your Parent Contact List. If you submit your parent contact list KSA Events will reach out to them directly to discuss how they can book their own trips to join the team. Remember you get discounts for every person that books with your group. This can help offset the cost of your coach's trip.

Step 6: Complete your Team Travel Agreement. Once we know which travel package the team has chosen, we will issue you an electronic travel agreement to complete and confirm the team package you have chosen.
