Public school choice is permitted by Massachusetts General Law (M.G.L.) Chapter 76, Section 12B. Local school committees are assumed to participate in public school choice unless a vote to opt out of public school choice is taken by the School Committee prior to June 1.

Your packet contains school choice numbers for Franklin Public Schools. We have not participated in accepting school choice students since the 2007-08 school year.

Although school choice could bring revenue (\$5000 per incoming student) during a difficult year financially for the district, I recommend that the Franklin School Committee vote to not accept any new public school choice students in the 2019-20 school year.

Should the School Committee wish to consider school choice in the future, I would recommend that the conversation be built into the budget development process beginning with the budget workshop in the fall.
