In March, I applied for a travel scholarship, funded by EF Tours, to attend a comparative educational study tour in Helsinki, Finland and Berlin, Germany which will involve touring schools, the Ministry of Education, and local educator preparation programs. The trip culminates in Berlin, Germany with an international educational leadership symposium, attended by educators and students, with a focus on the topic of "The Impact of Technology on Society".

I was awarded the scholarship based on my application, which included a focus on how I would use my learning experiences abroad to influence the District's Improvement Plan and strategic goals in educating students for contemporary, technology-infused, and interdependent society. 
