



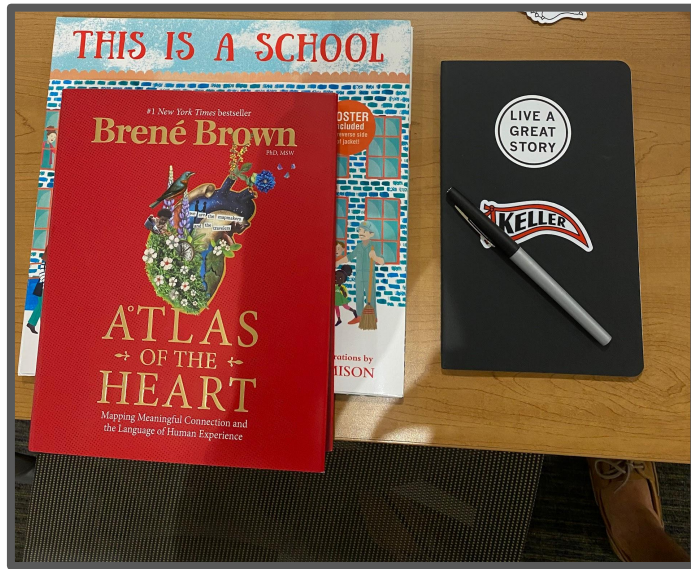

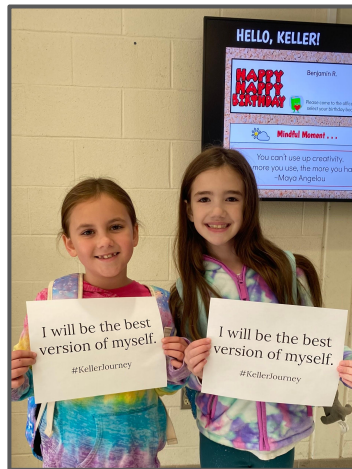

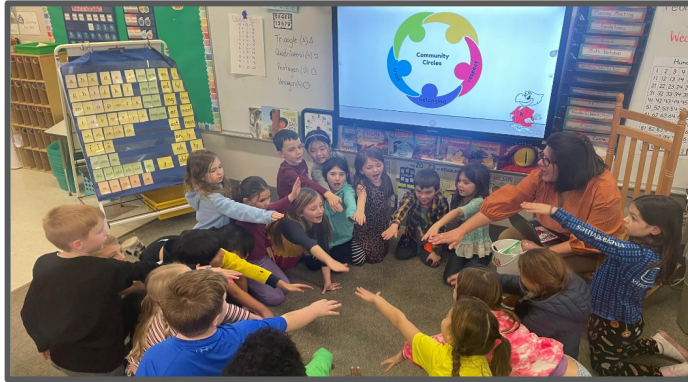

As we begin a new school year, we borrow a tradition launched by Clemson Head Football Coach, Dabo Swinney.

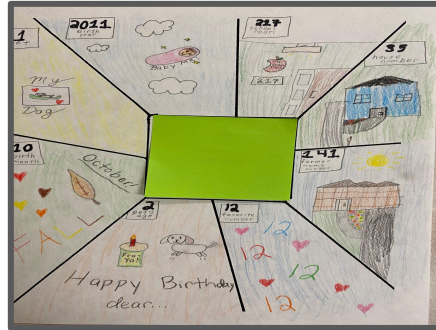
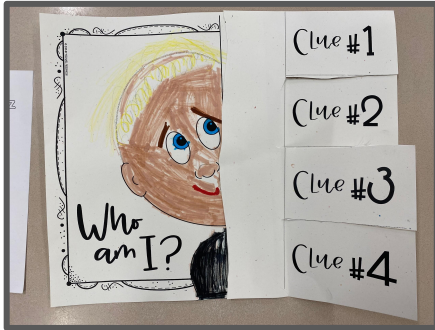
The message behind this tradition inspired us to go "All In."

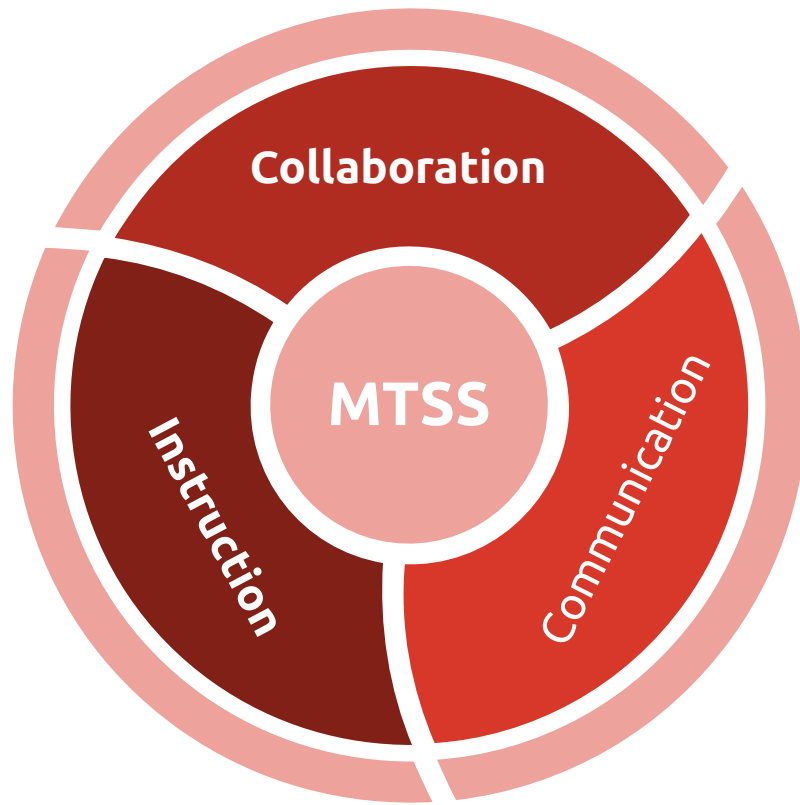
