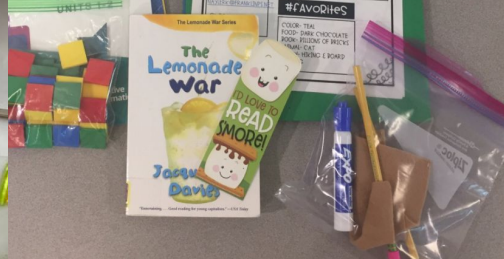
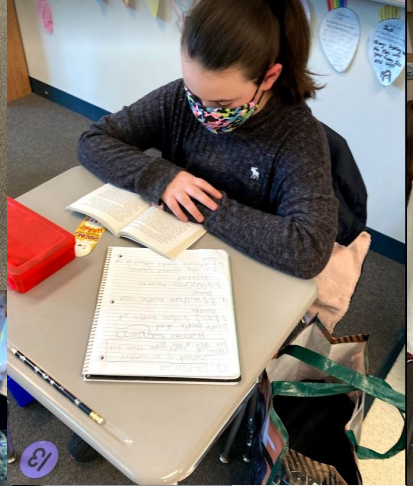
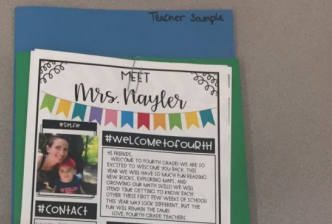
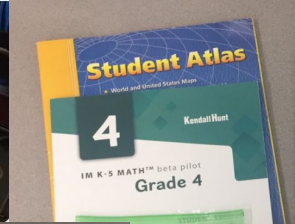


OAK INSTRUCTIONAL TENETS FOR 20/21
