Re: October 1 Enrollment Report

Enrollment data for Franklin Public Schools is being provided to you, as we customarily do every year.

Total enrollment for Franklin Public Schools is presented as compared to the Enrollment Forecast presented by demographer Jerry McKibben in the winter of 2020. Overall, the Franklin Public Schools enrollment approximates that which was forecast in 2020. What is noteworthy, is that some of the elementary schools have higher than projected enrollments and some are lower. This is likely due to the effects in the housing market.

Demographic information for the district is also presented. In the past five years, the percentage of students receiving free/reduced lunch has increased again this year by 2%. The value for 2020, 2021 and 2022 may be slightly inaccurate (low), however, since lunch is provided at no cost to students as a result of state funding. This may have resulted in families not applying, even if they would have qualified. We have also seen an increase in English learners from 82 to 93 in 2022-2023.

Student enrollment by race and ethnicity is also listed for the School Committee's review. We continue to see an increase in racial and ethnic diversity in the District.

Lastly, a chart displays some commonly attended school attendance options for Franklin resident children. We also display the trends over the past five years and point out:

- The increase of students at the elementary level attending the Benjamin Franklin Charter school increased in 2019-2020 expectedly, as this was the year of the school's initial expansion. The numbers have now decreased back to pre-expansion values.
- There is an expected increase of middle school students attending the Benjamin Franklin Charter in 2020-2021 as a result of expansion of the school in grade 6. These numbers have settled back to pre-expansion values as well.
- Homeschool numbers increased in 2020-2021 as a result of the pandemic (65). While lower in 2021-2022 (60), they continue to decrease in 2022-23 to 46 (close to normal, which is about 30).

•	High school students attending public schools other than Franklin in 2021-22 increased by 8.3% (318 to 379) in private/parochial school enrollment.
