Personnel and staffing for the 2020-2021 school year amidst a global pandemic continues to be a challenge, but changes have settled down. Earlier this year, we provided the Committee with a Comprehensive Personnel Update describing our new hires, departures from the district, revised and added positions, as well as unfilled vacancies, and furloughs/layoffs. Given how fluid the current school year has been, we are providing an update to the Committee at this time. As Miriam noted in the recent budget update, we continue to operate within our bottom line budget as approved by the School Committee

Layoffs Due to COVID-19 Reopening Plan

Department	Status
Lifelong Learning Solutions Music Academy Community Education 	 33 were furloughed in September, and as of 12/3/20, 11 currently provide music lessons and 12 furloughed employees now support a smaller Solutions program. Administrative hours were reduced as well. Where possible staff have been offered alternative work within the district. (e.g. monitors; subs)
Cafeteria Staff	37 were furloughed in September, and as of 12/3/20, 24 have since been laid off and the remaining 13 are currently serving meals to students during remote and hybrid instruction Where possible staff have been offered alternative work within the district. (e.g. monitors; subs)
