Open Questions

- 1. Will we be able to maintain enough staff in our schools to supervise in person learning as case counts climb and more staff members need to quarantine due to personal situations or school-related cases?
- 2. How can the district support staff to sustain the demands of teaching and learning in the hybrid and remote environments?

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Teaching and Learning

- 1. VLA Family Night. Mr. Kaufman is hosting a family meeting for VLA families on January 27, 2021. He will be joined by Dr. Edwards and one of the VLA teachers to have a conversation with families and answer questions.
- 2. Senior Internship. Dr. Edwards has applied to DESE to indicate the district's interest in having seniors in good standing participate in a paid internship by working in our elementary and/or middle schools later this winter and into the spring. Final details are being worked out regarding this program but we are excited that there is interest from about ten students. This will provide additional assistance in school buildings, particularly as college students return to school.

Digital Learning/Technology

Clarification of Tech Support.

- 1. When students are having technical difficulties, **the first step is to contact their teacher**.
- **2.** If the student is in school, the teacher will take steps to resolve the issue.
- **3.** If your student is at home, after contacting the teacher, go to the <u>FPS Technology Support</u> website.

For example, if it is a remote day for your student, follow these steps:

- 1. Notify the teacher
- 2. Visit the <u>FPS Technology Support</u> website
- 3. Choose the REMOTE button
- 4. Choose the *student at home* button to contact the Distance Learning Help Desk.

Whole Child Supports

1. Food Services: Grab and Go breakfast and lunch continue to be available behind Franklin High School Monday- Friday from 11am-1pm. All meals are free for everyone until June 30, 2021. Contactless pickup, or delivery can be arranged if needed.

Personnel

1. Vaccinations. We continue to remain informed about the phase 2 roll out of vaccinations, which will include educators. At this time, we do not have more concrete information on a timeline but have learned a lot through the vaccine clinics last week and this week and feel well informed should we be hosting a clinic here for staff.



Health and Safety

- 1. **Pool Testing.** FPS administration held information sessions for families and faculty/staff during the week of January 11. We also have been gathering survey information. Initial indication is that a large percentage of staff and a majority families are interested in pool testing. We anticipate that as further information is gathered and communicated, more participants will opt into the program.
 - **a.** Actions planned: District leaders will be attending a pool testing webinar on Friday, January 22, 2021. Another information session about BinaxNow antigen tests is planned for Tuesday, January 26, 2021 and we plan to attend.
 - b. Actions planned: We will issue additional communication in the coming days to families and faculty/staff on the pool testing pilot.
- **2. Travel Expectations.** We need to reiterate the message regarding FPS travel expectations so I am doing so here as well in the Superintendent's Report for this Committee meeting.

There are loopholes in the Executive Order where travelers can be tested up to 72 hours prior to arrival in Massachusetts. It is creating fear and worry and potential risk within FPS. <u>Therefore, it is the expectation of the Franklin Public Schools that children are tested for COVID upon return to Massachusetts.</u>

- a. Actions taken: We discussed this as part of the COVID Interim Policy review during the Policy Subcommittee meeting on Thursday, January 21, 2021.
- b. Actions taken: COVID-Handbooks and website has been updated.
