Open Questions

- 1. With new guidance from the state being issued, what practices will and won't change within Franklin Public Schools?

We are in the process of adapting to new guidance from the state. We anticipate more will be issued in the weeks to come. This includes guidance on:

- Wearing masks outdoors change recently implemented at outdoor recess, outdoor physical education, and other outdoor learning environments
- High School graduation HS administration is continuing to iterate the graduation plans
- Cleaning practices and sharing of materials no changes planned for the remainder of the school year

The Reopening Monitoring Team met on Tuesday, May 18, 2021. The group shared "Wow" moments and discussed the new guidance. They agreed that a June meeting is likely not needed so no June date is set. The group will convene, if necessary.
