

Brief History

- Teachers wanted to do work they couldn't get to during the year
- Developed a process for proposal submission and approvals
- Monitor and approve work products prior to stipend payment

Funding Amounts

Almost \$80,000 requested

Funded approximately \$50,000

- Funded almost \$40,000 general education
- Funded almost \$11,000 special education
