Welcome back to everyone and Happy New Year 2018!

Update on Keller/Sullivan Building Complex

Over vacation, the Keller classrooms and hallways, which were impacted by water with the faulty sprinkler head, were rebuilt. After the space was certified as treated properly to prevent mold growth (by OccuHealth, Inc.), construction began. Over vacation, walls were repaired and carpets were replaced.

Yesterday, educators worked to set up their classrooms once again and students were moved back into the rooms today.

Cubbies will take a little more time to install. In some rooms, cubbies were destroyed and new cubbies have been ordered and will take approximately 10-12 weeks to arrive, after which they will be installed over a weekend. Students are able to use cubbies in nearby rooms.

The response from the Keller community has been stellar -- demonstrating both flexibility as well as a resolve to get classrooms back up and running. Kudos to our administrators, our faculty, our students, and the Facilities department!

In the long term, we are concerned about sprinkler heads at this complex. Our insurance company is investigating the situation in order to be proactive in the future.
