Superintendent's Report to School Committee July 14, 2020 School Committee Meeting

MASS Executive Institute

Dr. Edwards, Mr. Giguere and I are attending the Massachusetts Association of School Superintendent's Executive Institute, being held virtually July 14-15, 2020.

The focus of the first day has been on reopening school. Topics include technical aspects about opening such as safety standards, scheduling, legal matters such as collective bargaining and situations with employees. A bigger focus of breakout sessions include aspects of social and emotional well-being of students and staff as well as empathetic communication from district leaders. Today's keynote address was delivered by Dr. Romei Rushtaq, a traditionally trained neurologist with board certification in integrative medicine. She led the group through a focused discussion on self-care.

Tomorrow's professional development is focused on Equity and Racial Justice. The keynote will be delivered by Douglas Brinkley, the Katherine Tsanoff Brown Chair in Humanities and professor of history at Rice University. Brinkley is the history commentator for CNN, and a contributing editor to the magazine Vanity Fair. Breakout sessions and panel discussions will occur later in the day.

The conference concludes with remarks from Commissioner Riley.
