Children & Teen Classes (6wks) Sat., April 6th – May 11th, 2024

NEW! Grades K-3: *Me On the Map!* Kids Drawing & Painting w/Cathy Martin, 10-11:30am. Explore art from around the world while learning to draw and paint unique masterpieces. The pottery of ancient Greece and more will inspire us. Costs: \$171 mem; \$181 non-mem *(materials included)* NEW! Grades 4-8: *Sketch What You See!* Drawing from Observation w/Lisa Granata, 10am-12pm. NEW! Splash of Color! Intermediate Watercolors w/Kris Occhino, (6wks) Tues, Apr 2nd-May 14th; 10:30am-1:00pm. No class 4/16. Let the vibrant colors of spring and summer inspire your paintings as you learn to use light and texture while developing your personal style. Demonstrations on a variety of techniques will be given. Be inspired by New England's ever-changing land, sea and skies for subject matter. Costs: \$163 mem; \$178 non-mem. Students provide materials*

NEW! For the Love of Paint! Beginner's Watercolor w/Kris Occhino, (6wks) Tues, Apr 2nd-May 14th; 2-3:30pm. No class 4/16. If you've never tried watercolor, this is the course for you... let's explore the fundamentals. Students will gain skills through a series of exercises that will lead them up to painting a floral still-life. Basic techniques will be discussed and demonstrated including graded washes, glazing, "pulling" color, color mixing and creating textures. Be adventurous and have fun exploring this transparent medium! Costs: \$78 mem; \$86 non-mem. *Students provide materials**

NEW! *Fill the Paper*! Expressive Drawing w/Lisa Granata, (8wks) Tues, April 2nd-May 21st; 6:45pm-9:45pm. Develop a unique portfolio of "works on paper" by discovering the expressive qualities of drawing and techniques to encourage reactive and intuitive artmaking. Students will expand their visual language working from the still-life, landscape, and figure (a digital clothed model). Demonstrations will be presented on ink wash, charcoals, pastels and more! Costs: \$210 mem; \$230 non-mem. *Students provide materials**

NEW! *A Fine Print*! Exploring Acrylic Monotypes w/Mike Perry, (4wks) Wed, April 24th-May 15th; 10:30am-1:30pm. Explore the art of the unique print! Use a painterly style to apply acrylics to a plexiglass plate and then transfer the image to paper by using a hand-pressure baren. Develop your knowledge and skills in the use of basic tools techniques and processes for achieving one-of-a-kind prints. Costs: \$105 mem; \$115 non-mem. *Students provide materials**
