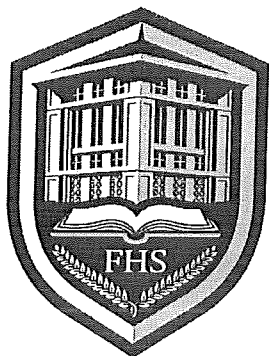
Boys Ice Hockey Team Trip
