

## Student Registration Checklist ~ PreK-8th Grade

Į	<b>PROOF OF RESIDENCE</b> : Can be obtained from the Superintendent's Office (3 <sup>rd</sup> Floor – Franklin
	Municipal Building; 355 East Central Street) Only Parents/Guardians may register their children. Please
	bring with you the documentation listed below - ONE box from Column A, AND ONE item from
	Column B.

Please note: the Town Census is not considered "Proof of Residency".

If you	Column A <u>Evidence of Residency</u>
Are a Homeowner	☐ Property tax bill  OR ☐ Recent mortgage statement  OR ☐ Signed closing documents  (utility bills are not accepted)
Are a Renter	□Copy of Lease (FPS reserves the right to verify with Landlord).
Tenant at Will (no formal lease)	OR  □Landlord Affidavit (notarized document)
Live with someone	□Homeowner or lease holder must sign a notarized affidavit (available at Superintendent's office) verifying you are a member of their household, <i>AND</i> they must provide evidence of residency (see above).

ORIGINAL BIRTH CERTIFICATE: Legal or official court documents are required for individual acting as legal guardian. Birth Certificate must have official seal. Your child must be five years of age of or before August 31st of the year they will enter Kindergarten.
CUSTODIAL PARENT DOCUMENTATION: Single parents must bring legal documentation verifying they have physical custody of the child/children (i.e. court order, divorce document or a notarized custody form provided by Central Office). This includes separation, shared and joint custody arrangements.
IMMUNIZATION RECORDS / PHYSICAL EXAM: Physician's copy of child's immunization records. Must be current before entry into school. Physical examinations are required for any new studer to be within the past year. Physical exam forms can be obtained at the school or from your physician Subsequent physical exams are required in grades 5, 7 and 10. For students entering kindergarten, the State requires vision screening within one year of entry.
