- 1. School Safety encompasses the practices and procedures we use to keep students physically, emotionally, and psychologically safe.
- 2. We maintain open lines of communication with the Franklin Police Department and Franklin Fire Department in order to promote the safety and security of students within our buildings.
- 3. School safety is an iterative process that involves planning, training, implementation, communication, and reflection.
- 4. We use both physical security measures as well as relationships to promote safety within our schools.
- 5. Part of keeping safe is promoting a safe culture and climate, which we pursue through our social-emotional learning curriculum.
