

TRANSPORTATION UPDATE

The transportation department has been preparing for the upcoming 2018-2019 school year. Consistent with Mass General Law, the School Committee policy affords students in kindergarten through grade 6 who live over 2 miles from their district school to ride at no cost. Students K-6 within the 2 mile range and all students in grades 7 through 12 have the opportunity to "Pay-to-Ride". The cost remains at \$325 per student with a cap of \$975 per family.

Eligibility notices are being mailed shortly, so all families should get a letter for each student enrolled. This begins our active sign up period for Pay-to-Ride for the 2018-2019 school year. We expect to register over 2,000 students in the next two months, so be sure to [sign up online](#) on or before June 11, 2018 to guarantee a seat if needed.

High School and Middle School buses fill up quickly.
