Dear Superintendent Giguere,

I'm respectfully requesting to schedule the Franklin High School Class of 2024 graduation on Friday, May 31, 2024. Traditionally, Franklin High School graduations were held on the first Friday in June, which is June 7, 2024. Our goal is to schedule graduation for the first weekend in June, which I understand is a change in practice and interpretation. The request is made for the following reasons.

- 1. Senior Week historically follows Memorial Day weekend, which takes place on Monday, May 27, 2024, ending with graduation on that Friday. This allows the cadence of the senior week of events to stay in the same order, which includes multiple days of rehearsals. We also avoid an additional week of time lapse before the graduation ceremony. This is helpful for planning and staffing the events leading up to and including Senior Week and mitigating positional issues from occurring the week before graduation.
- 2. Bio MCAS is scheduled to be taken on June 4 and June 5, 2024. If graduation stays on June 7, 2024, this would be during our typical Senior Week Events/Graduation Rehearsal. Attempting to conduct and administer both events during the same week thoughtfully is doable but certainly not optimal.
- 3. Many area High Schools are graduating that weekend.
 - o 5/30 Bishop Feehan
 - o 5/31 Hopkinton, Blackstone Millville Regional, Nipmuc
 - o 6/1 Randolph, Avon, Uxbridge, Hopedale
 - o 6/2 Walpole, Mansfield, Milton, Milford, Needham
- 4. We are within the guidelines of what the State of Massachusetts allows. If we have graduation on 5/31/24, we would have 10 school days before the regularly scheduled closing date of the school on 6/14/24.
 - As a matter of policy, the Board encourages school districts to schedule high school graduation as close as
 possible to the scheduled closing date of the high school to maximize the learning time offered to
 graduating seniors and minimize the disruption of instruction provided to other students.
 - Notwithstanding the minimum school year requirements set forth in 603 CMR 27.03 and 27.04(2), at the discretion of the school committee, the scheduled school year for the graduating senior class of a high school or vocational/technical school may conclude. The school graduation may be held up to 12 school days before the regularly scheduled closing date of that school.
- 5. The FHS current schedule only allows for one week between graduation and the last day of school w/out snow days (June 7 & June 14, 2023). The additional week would allow more time for a seamless transition to close out the year for grade 9-11, step up days for freshman, and closing out underclassmen awards. This would also allow us to reinstitute the Junior book awards in the additional week gained.

6. The next time this will occur is in the year 2030.
